

## **SHELF MUSHROOMS NF6253**

## INSTRUCTIONS

To install, drill a hole in the log, or tree, with a 3/8" (9.52 mm) drill bit. Apply a generous amount of glue, insert planting pin and hold in place. We recommend using a hot glue gun to secure.

## **Tips and Techniques**

- To make it appear as if the Shelf Mushroom is growing from the log or tree, apply Soil Base (NF6200-NF6202) or Highlight (NF6208-NF6211) along the joint area between the Mushroom and the log. Secure with Habitat Adhesive™ (NF6099). This will add the appearance of rotted wood debris.
- · We recommend installing Shelf Mushrooms in clusters as a whole set, or in partial sets of two or three. Start by installing the lowest Mushroom in the cluster and work toward the top, fanning them out in a layered cluster.
- · Moss often grows on logs and sometimes appears to grow on mushrooms, too. Create this effect by applying moss to the log and/or the Shelf Mushroom where it attaches to the log. Make moss using Accents (NF6217-NF6220) or Static Fiber™ (NF6115-NF6130) applied with the Static King® (NF6100) and Fiber-Tac® (NF6102).
- Customize Shelf Mushrooms by painting them with matte-finish paints.
